

Consumer Representative to the Consortium Board of Directors

Position Description

One seat on the Arizona Psychology Training Consortium's Board of Directors is reserved for a Consumer Representative.

Eligibility:

The Consumer Representative shall be chosen from among current supervisees whose sites are Affiliates of the Consortium. Term: This is a one-year term, beginning with the election of the Representative and concluding at the end of the Board's next Annual Meeting.

Election:

The Consumer Representative shall be elected by a majority of the then-current supervisees. Candidates may be nominated by their peers, and self-nominations are permitted.

Duties:

The Board of Directors is a policy-level body. The Consumer Representative is expected to give voice to the interests and concerns of the Consortium's supervisees, as well as to participate in discussions and actions regarding the operation, health, and future of the Consortium. Attendance at Board of Directors meetings is expected. These are scheduled at least quarterly, due notice being provided by the Board's President or its Secretary.
